

THE NFPI HOME STUDY COURSE

What is it? The NFPI Home Study Course is an excellent and convenient way for couples to complete an NFP course for self-instruction and for marriage preparation.

What will you do and learn?

In the NFPI Home Study Course, you will:

- Read the NFPI manual, *Natural Family Planning: The Complete Approach*.
- Learn how to observe, record, and interpret the signs of female fertility.
- Apply that knowledge to achieve or avoid pregnancy.
- Learn about the natural spacing of births with ecological breastfeeding.
- Learn Catholic teaching about love, marriage, sexuality, and the family.

What's the process?

You will complete a series of three tests based upon the NFPI manual, *Natural Family Planning: The Complete Approach*. We will send you one test at a time based on a few chapters in the manual. Then you will show that you can interpret charts.

Certificate of Completion. When you complete the course, NFPI will send you a certificate.

• Obtain Natural Family Planning: The Complete Approach in one of two ways:

- 1. At www.NFPandmore.org under the image of the manual, select **To purchase a published copy**. We recommend the **coil** (spiral) edition for practical use because the coil edition lies flat. The printed manual costs only about \$10 more than the downloaded manual and will last for years.
- 2. Or you can download the manual. At the website above, underneath the image of the manual, select **To download this NFP manual**. Use 3-hole paper and a binder. It has 156 pages.
- Free charts can be downloaded at the NFPI Home Page.
- A **basal digital thermometer** is available at the left-hand **And More** column of the NFPI Home Page. You might also be able to get a good quality basal thermometer at your local pharmacy.
